FY26 OxyChem First Responder Donation Program

Background Information

OxyChem First Responder Donation Program is dedicated to supporting First Responders in local communities.

The OxyChem First Responder Donations Program supports community fire departments, emergency medical services, and law enforcement agencies. Donation funding is for needs such as the purchase, repair or replacement of line-of-duty emergency response equipment, rescue, and safety gear, and first responder safety training.

The City of Corpus Christi has received an award of \$10,000.



Background Information

This grant will provide funding for:

To support the cost to purchase and outfit a CCFD high profile multi-terrain response vehicle to be used primarily for removing people from flooded and hard-to-reach areas.

CCFD currently does not have a high-water rescue vehicle in its fleet. The high-water rescue vehicle is ideal for flooded and hard-to-reach areas, and it would have a sked stretcher which could be added or removed as needed to convert it into a Type 3 brush truck when not used as a high-water rescue vehicle.
