Summary



Ordinance authorizing updates to the City of Corpus Christi's Texas Municipal Retirement System.

- Adopting non-retroactive repeating COLAs for retirees and their beneficiaries under Texas Municipal Retirement System Act
- Authorizing annually accruing updated service credits



Highlights



- Texas Legislature amended the TMRS Act to provide participating cities with a new non-retroactive COLA option effective January 1, 2024.
- The Legislation eliminates the retroactive calculation.
- The annuities of TMRS retirees will increase by 30% of the 2022 Consumer Price Index (CPI).
- Adopting the non-retroactive COLA will decrease the City's TMRS contribution rate from 16.57% to 16.29% creating an approximate savings of \$435,000 for FY24 and similar savings for future years.
