

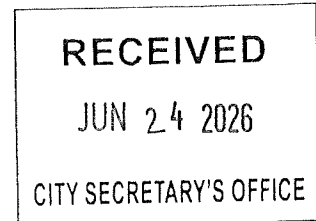

SUBJECT: Motion authorizing staff to work with WSP for the execution of all documents necessary to apply for and accept U.S. Bureau of Reclamation Grant fund for the construction of the Inner Harbor Seawater Desalination Treatment Plant.

ACTION REQUEST:

Per Council Policy 16.d., we request that the following item be placed on the next available City Council agenda, June 30, 2026, for discussion and possible action regarding.


Motion to authorize staff to work with WSP for the execution of all documents necessary to apply for and accept the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) Grant fund for the construction of the Inner Harbor Seawater Desalination Treatment Plant.

The program could provide up to \$120 million for planning, design, and construction of the Inner Harbor Desalination Treatment Plant.

Eligibility for projects includes:

1. The project must be constructed, operated, and maintained by an eligible applicant;
 - a. Eligible applicants include States, Tribes, municipalities, irrigation districts, water districts, or wastewater districts.

2. The project must have a completed feasibility study submitted to the BOR for review by June 26, 2026, and the completed feasibility study must meet all BOR requirements by November 20, 2026.
3. Estimated total project cost greater than or equal to \$500 million.
4. The project must be included in a state-approved plan.
