

Ordinance authorizing the acceptance of a grant award totaling \$4,000.00 from the 2024 Helping Heroes Program from Flint Hills Resources; to support the Corpus Christi - Nueces County Local Emergency Planning Committee by providing funding for 115 Shelter-in-Place kits which will be distributed to area school districts; and appropriating the funds into the Fire Grants Fund.

WHEREAS, the City of Corpus Christi (“City”) authorizes a grant award from the Flint Hills Resources Helping Heroes Program, in an amount totaling \$4,000.00, for emergency Shelter-in-Place Kits which will be distributed to area school districts.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes the City Manager, or his designee (“City Manager”), to accept grants on behalf of the City from Flint Hills Resources for shelter-in-place kits.

SECTION 2. The grant funds totaling \$4,000.00 are appropriated into the FY 2026 Fire Grant Fund.

SECTION 3. The Fire Chief, Brandon Wade, is designated as the City’s authorized official to administer this grant. The authorized official is empowered to apply for, accept, reject or terminate the grant and its funding, execute all necessary documents, and administer the award on behalf of the City.

SECTION 4. In the event of the loss or misuse of these funds, the City assures the grant funds will be returned to the grantor in accordance with the applicable grant requirements.
