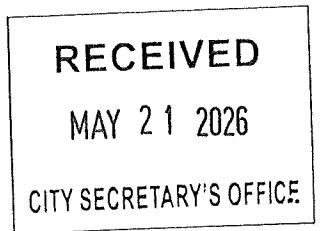

RESPONDENT GIL HERNANDEZ'S WRITTEN RESPONSE

Submitted pursuant to City of Corpus Christi Code of Ethics, Section 2-330(e)(3)

Introduction

Council Member Gil Hernandez, by and through his attorney Kevin O'Hanlon, submits this written response to the ethics complaint filed by Sondra K. Meyer on April 29, 2026. This response is submitted under Section 2-330(e)(3) of the City of Corpus Christi Code of Ethics. The City Attorney issued a preliminary determination on May 8, 2026 finding the complaint sufficient as to form, and the Commission has the complaint on its agenda for the May 21, 2026 meeting under the item addressing outstanding ethics complaints. Respondent asks that the Commission consider this response at that meeting and, for the reasons set out below, determine not to schedule a hearing and take no further action on the complaint.

A finding of sufficiency under Section 2-330(e)(1) is only a threshold screen. It asks whether the complaint is proper in form and whether, if the alleged facts were true, they would state a prima facie violation. It is not a finding that Council Member Hernandez did anything wrong. Taken on its own terms, the complaint does not describe a violation of the single rule it invokes, Section 2-311(8)(e). The conduct it complains of, asking that items be placed on a council agenda, speaking in council deliberations, and casting votes, is the ordinary and lawful work of an elected council member. None of it fits the rule.

I. The rule the complaint invokes

The complaint relies on one provision, Section 2-311(8)(e). As quoted in the complaint, that section provides that elected city officials may not:

use their position to influence the action of a city official or city employee in the performance of their duties related to a contract or business transaction involving an individual or organization who contributed to the official's campaign contributions during the most recent election either directly, or indirectly via a third party.

By its terms, the rule requires several things together: (1) the official used his position; (2) to influence the action of a city official or city employee; (3) in the performance of that other person's duties; (4) related to a contract or business transaction; (5) involving a person or organization; (6) who contributed to his campaign during the most recent election. Even assuming the contributions at issue fall within the most recent election, the complaint still fails because the conduct it describes does not satisfy the remaining elements, each of which is independently required.

II. The complaint does not allege that Council Member Hernandez influenced any city official or employee

The rule reaches a narrow thing: using one's position to influence the action of a city official or city employee in how that other person performs their duties. Casting one's own vote is not influencing another official. Speaking during deliberation is not influencing an employee. Co-signing a three-signature memorandum to place an item on the agenda is the exercise of a procedural right that belongs to council members under Council Policy 16.d. It asks the City Secretary to calendar an item, which is a ministerial act, and it does not direct or pressure any official or employee in the performance of their duties.

The complaint concedes the point. It states that the only way for Council Member Hernandez to have avoided the rule would have been to refrain from participation in city business, that without participating his name would not appear on the three-signature memoranda, and that he would not have voted. The Code of Ethics does not require an elected official to stop doing his job. A reading of the rule that turns ordinary deliberation and voting into a violation is not what the rule says.

III. None of the matters was a contract or business transaction involving a contributor

The rule applies only where the alleged influence concerns a contract or business transaction involving a campaign contributor. The matters the complaint lists are not contracts or business transactions, and none involves the named contributor as a party. Those matters are an internal review of the City Auditor's conduct and compensation, whether to retain outside counsel, correcting the City's Legistar records to match the official record, and the petition and articles to remove the Mayor.

The removal of a sitting mayor is a governance and disciplinary proceeding, not a business deal. The auditor matter and the records correction are internal oversight. The one item that involves an actual agreement, the Homewood Suites Type B economic development incentive, is a contract between the City and the developer, Elevate QOF, LLC, whose owners are Phillip Ramirez and Deven Bhakta. The contributors named in the complaint, Mr. David and his hotel entities, are not parties to that incentive. They are competitors who opposed it. Mr. David has no contract or business transaction with the City. He is a litigant who sued the City and a citizen whose allegations the Council addressed through investigation and a Charter process. Considering those allegations, keeping the public record accurate, and weighing a citizen's removal petition is not using a position to favor a contributor's contract or business transaction, because the contributor

has none before the Council. The rule's reference to a contribution made indirectly via a third party describes how a contribution reaches an official; it does not turn a contributor's opposition to another company's incentive into a business transaction involving the contributor.

IV. The complaint shows no influence and no benefit, only a lawful, reported contribution

Even setting the text aside, the complaint offers no facts showing that Council Member Hernandez used a contribution to influence anyone, or that any contributor gained from the actions he took. The complaint repeatedly notes that he was one of three, or one of several, acting alongside his colleagues. Joining lawful, public council action with other members does not show that a campaign contribution drove an outcome. That a litigant such as Mr. David may have favored an investigation or a Charter petition does not make a council member's participation an ethics violation; the rule reaches a contract or business transaction involving the contributor, and there is none here.

The premise that contributions drove Council Member Hernandez's votes collapses on the record. In the election cycle when the \$2 million Homewood Suites Type B incentive was before the Council, he received more from the developer's owners than he later received from Mr. David. His campaign finance reports show \$2,000 from Phillip Ramirez on September 29, 2022 and \$1,000 from Deven Bhakta on October 27, 2022, a total of \$3,000 from the developer's side, compared with \$2,500 from Mr. David. He nonetheless scrutinized the developer's incentive and declined to support it. If contributions controlled his votes, the larger contributions would point the other way.

His votes on that incentive bear this out. Council Member Hernandez voted for the incentive on first reading on February 20, 2024. After the Council was informed that the FEMA documentation supporting the request had been altered, and given the changes to the agreement between the first and second readings, he abstained on second reading. His position throughout has been to demand integrity in the use of taxpayer-funded economic incentives, which is the opposite of being steered by a contribution.

The contributions at issue were disclosed on Council Member Hernandez's campaign finance reports, filed with the City and available to the public. The complaint itself relies on those public reports as its source for the contributions it describes, which shows the contributions were transparent and a matter of public record. A contribution that is lawful and publicly reported does not become an ethics violation because the contributor later has unrelated business before the City.

V. The rule imposes no disclosure or recusal duty, and the statutory conflict rules do not apply

The complaint argues that Council Member Hernandez should at a minimum have disclosed the contributions before participating. Section 2-311(8)(e) contains no such requirement. The duty to disclose and abstain arises under Chapter 171 of the Texas Local Government Code, which applies only where an official has a substantial interest in a business entity or in real property that

is the subject of the matter. See Tex. Loc. Gov't Code Sections 171.002 and 171.004. A campaign contributor is not a substantial interest, and the complaint does not allege one. The complaint cannot manufacture a disclosure or recusal duty that neither the ordinance nor the statute imposes.

VI. Speaking and voting are protected functions of an elected official

Speaking and voting on matters of public concern are core functions of an elected council member. Reading Section 2-311(8)(e) to penalize a member for deliberating and voting, with no clear textual prohibition and no facts showing improper influence, would raise serious concerns and is not what the rule provides.

Conclusion

Even taken as true, the complaint does not state a violation of Section 2-311(8)(e). Council Member Hernandez respectfully asks the Commission to determine, under Section 2-330(e)(4), not to schedule a hearing and to take no further action on the complaint.
