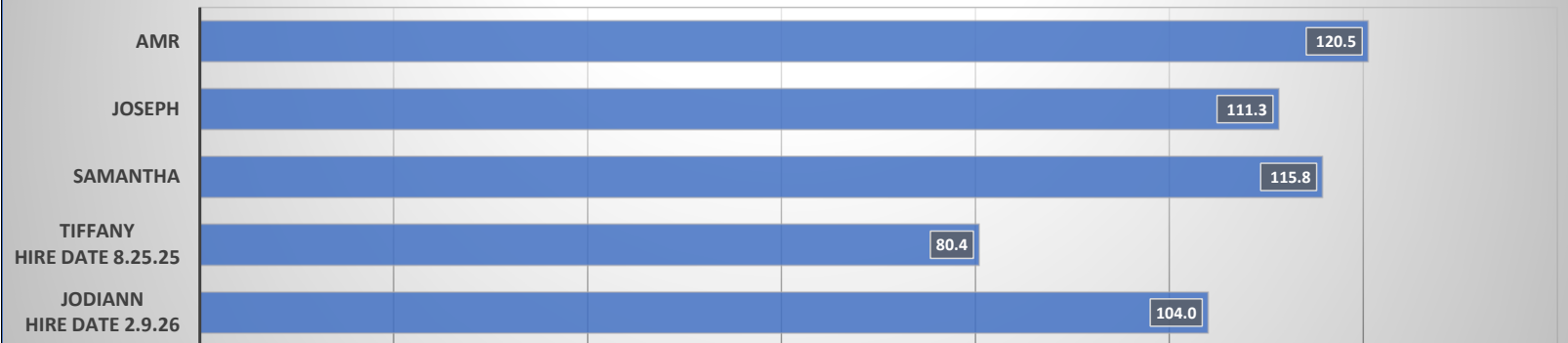

Employees who commence employment after the start of the applicable two-year GAGAS CPE measurement period are subject to a prorated CPE requirement based on their hire date and the remaining portion of the measurement cycle; accordingly, individual compliance status for such employees should be evaluated against their prorated requirement rather than the full biennial threshold.</i>
