Ordinance authorizing execution of all documents necessary to apply for and accept the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation Grants for the construction of the Inner Harbor Seawater Desalination Treatment Plant; appropriating funds.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS THAT:

- **SECTION 1.** The City Council authorizes execution of all documents necessary for submission of the grant applications to the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation for the Inner Harbor Seawater Desalination Treatment Plant Project.
- **SECTION 2.** The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept grants from the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation.
- **SECTION 3**. An amount up to \$180,000,000.00 is appropriated in the Water CIP Fund 4080.
- **SECTION 4.** The City Manager, Assistant City Managers, Chief Operating Officer and the City Manager's designee are authorized to execute contractual documents between the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and City.
- **SECTION 5.** The Director of Finance & Business Analysis, Controller, and the City Manager's designee are authorized to execute financial documents between the U.S. Bureau of Reclamation and the City.
