

Chemical Analysis Testing for Corpus Christi Water

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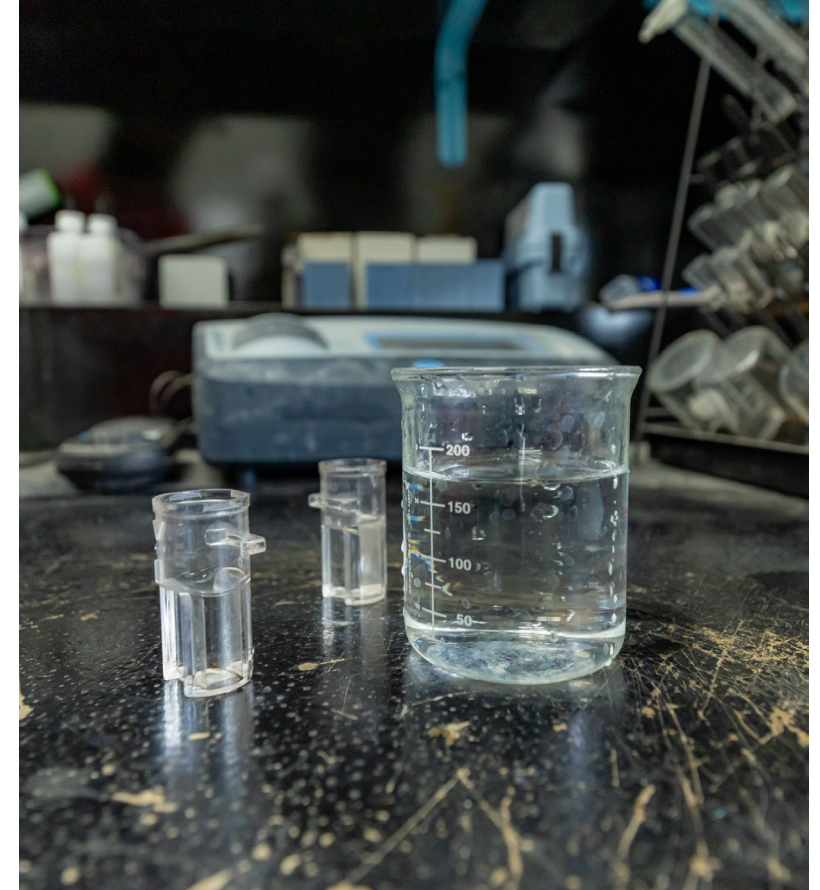
Background

- The Water Utilities Laboratory provides analytical testing services for the City of Corpus Christi and numerous other customers
- However, there are tests that fall outside the capability of the Water Utilities Laboratory that necessitate the establishment of this contract



Background

- This motion authorizes a one-year agreement, with three one-year options, with Eurofins Environment Testing South Central, LLC, for chemical testing and analysis of water and wastewater samples for Corpus Christi Water
- The agreement provides unit pricing for a set quantity of analyses, where funds are only expended for services rendered
- This agreement will ensure the City of Corpus Christi satisfies the analytical testing requirements as per TCEQ (Texas Commission on Environmental Quality) permit requirements
- **The current contract with Eurofins Environment Testing South Central, LLC became effective June 16, 2023. The contract has been utilized by the Water Utilities Lab, Wastewater Pretreatment and the Wastewater Treatment Plants**



Fiscal Impact

The fiscal impact for FY 2026 for the 4010 Water Fund is \$25,800.00, and \$90,562.00 for the 4200 Wastewater Fund, for a total of \$116,362.00. The Water Fund will be reimbursed by the Wastewater Fund through the inter-departmental services account for services provided by the Water Utilities Laboratory.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends approval of the resolution authorizing a one-year service agreement, with three one-year extension options, with Eurofins Environment Testing South Central, LLC, as presented.
