Summary and Background

2023 Tuberculosis Prevention and Control-Federal (TB/PC-FED) Grant

- Propose of the Tuberculosis Prevention and Control-Federal (TB/PC-FED) Grant is to provide for personnel costs to offer services and associated activities to prevent and control tuberculosis within the jurisdiction of the Corpus Christi-Nueces County Public Health District (CCNCPHD).
 - Grant contract period from January 1, 2023, and will go through December 31, 2023
 - This grant is an award with funding in the amount of \$48,348.00, with a 20% match by the City.
 - DSHS is allowing the CCNCPHD to use 20% of the annual salary of the TB Program Manager who is paid by the City of Corpus Christi General Fund to satisfy the 20% grant match requirement.

Fiscal Impact and Staff Recommendation

2023 Tuberculosis Prevention and Control-Federal (TB/PC-FED) Grant

Fiscal Impact:

- Acceptance of the grant requires that the City of Corpus Christi contribute a cash match of 20% (\$9,760) of the grant amount of \$48,348. The City match has been included in various accounts for FY 2023.
 - 1 FTE grant funded position
