

Ordinance authorizing acceptance of a grant from the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department under its Boating Access Grant Program, in the amount of \$249,990.00, with a required cash match of \$83,330.00, for Phase 1 of the Packery Channel Boat Ramp Renovation Project; appropriating \$249,990.00 in the Parks & Recreation Grants Fund; and amending the FY 2026 Capital Budget.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Manager, or his designee ("City Manager"), is authorized to execute all documents necessary to accept funding of \$249,990.00 from the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department under its Boating Access Grant Program for Phase 1 of the Packery Channel Boat Ramp Renovation Project.

SECTION 2. Funding in the amount of \$249,990.00 is appropriated in the Parks & Recreation Grants Fund, with a cash match of up to \$83,330.00 to be provided from approved operating funds.

SECTION 3. The City Manager is authorized to execute contract amendments pertaining to these grant funds in the following instances: (a) for the carryover of funds, when ascertained and approved by the funding agency through a revised notice of award; (b) a no-cost extension; (c) when an amendment will provide supplemental grant funds in an amount not to exceed 20% of the original grant amount; (d) for reimbursement increases of administration funds for each participant served; (e) to comply with applicable State or federal laws and regulations; and (f) for matters which do not change the essential purpose of the grant.

SECTION 4. The City's FY 2026 Capital Budget, approved by Ordinance No. 033731, is amended by increasing both revenues and expenditures by \$333,320.00.

SECTION 4. The City of Corpus Christi designates the Director of Parks & Recreation as the City's authorized official. The authorized official is authorized to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the funding on behalf of the City.

SECTION 5. In the event of the loss or misuse of these funds, the City of Corpus Christi assures that the funds will be returned to the Texas Parks & Wildlife Department in full.
