Once a director has served for a total of six consecutive years, unless an exception under the City Charter applies, his or her term shall immediately expire and his or her position shall become vacant. Three directors must be persons who are not employees, officers or members of the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi. Each director must be a resident and qualified elector of the City. Directors may also serve as Directors for the Corpus Christi Business and Job Development Corporation (CCBJDC). If a Director serves on both the Corporation's board and the CCBJDC's board, the expiration of the Director's term on the Corporation's board shall coincide with the expiration of his/her term on the board of the CCBJDC. The City Council may appoint a City Council member as a non-voting liaison to the corporation for purposes of facilitating communication between the City Council and the board.






