RECAP



- Storm Water Division moved under Public Works Department in 2021.
 - FY22 Storm Water Program was created.
 - Implementation of Citywide Street sweeping that was never done before.
 - This contract is dedicated for City's residential streets and SPID corridor between Ayers Street to Airline Road.
 - Plan is to transition all street sweeping to In-House by FY28.

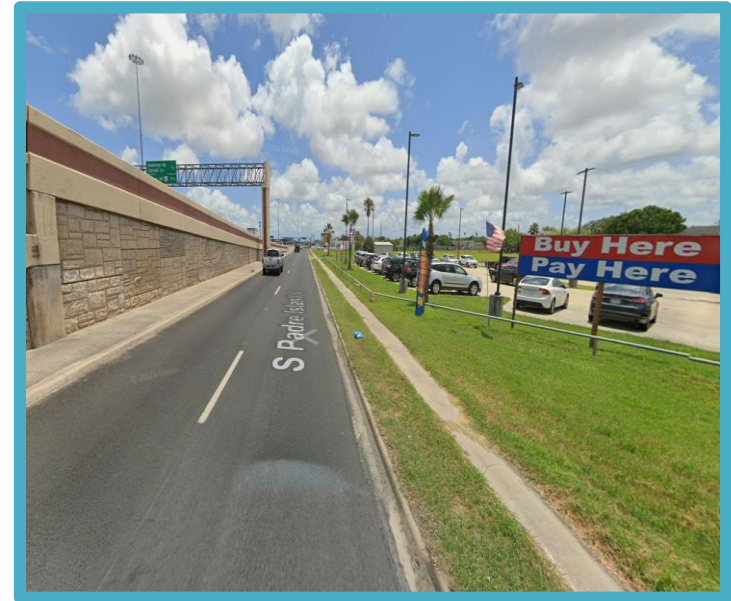

SPID Beautification

- Currently, TxDOT sweeps and cleans the frontage roads 1 time a month
- The City will supplement street sweeping and debris clean-up by adding 3 additional monthly cycles
- Frontage roads and underpasses from Ayers St. to Airline Rd. will be swept and cleaned 4 times a month utilizing both contracts
- Estimated Completion: 12-month Cycle
