

**Resolution Amending the City of Corpus Christi’s State Legislative Agenda for the 88<sup>th</sup> Texas Legislature relating to legislation involving the Port of Corpus Christi**

The City of Corpus Christi hereby amends its legislative agenda to add the following underlined item related to legislation involving the Port of Corpus Christi:

**Port of Corpus Christi**

Preserve the power of the City of Corpus Christi to appoint 3 members of the governing board of the Port of Corpus Christi. Oppose Legislation that would expand the authority of the Port of Corpus Christi beyond their role and responsibility to maintain and promote navigable commerce. Oppose legislation that would expand the unilateral economic development and real estate development authority of the Port of Corpus Christi. Support the Passage of legislation placing the Port Authority under Texas Sunset Advisory Commission review.
