

Holly Road

City Service Center on Civitan Drive

- Industrial hub for City services
- Consists of 85 acres of various operations
- Stores millions worth of city assets

Richter Street

Sacky Park

- Located at 2719 Sacky Drive
- Approximately 7 acres of mixed-use park space
- Unusually positioned against the border of the City's service center on Civitan Drive
- Very low public use



Holly Road

Sacky Park

- Proposed to reduce Sacky Park to 5.5 acres
- Approximately 1.5 acres will become park of the Civitan Service Center
- Amenities that will remain
- Very little change on how the park is currently enjoyed





Service Center and Sacky Park Challenges

- Casual public park access at Sacky Park has presented a higher risk of crime to the service center
- City services have grown significantly, where the need for basic employee accommodations (e.g. parking and storage) at the site are no longer adequate
- Land allotments are also no longer sufficient for departments who have grown in recent years



Service Center Masterplan & Public Land Redistribution

- Upon approval of the FY 2025 CIP, Asset
 Management finalized the service center master
 plan to address these challenges
- Redistributes Sacky Park and repurposes the public land for enhanced City operations pursuant to Texas Parks and Wildlife Code Title 3 Chapter 26
- Increases service connectivity and improves emergency accessibility to the site
- Staff Recommends approval as presented
