Approval of TIRZ #3 Downtown Development Reimbursement Agreement with Furman Foundry, LLC at 418 Peoples Street for Thunderbird Wine & Spirits Retail Space

CAPTION:

Motion to approve a Downtown Development Agreement with Furman Foundry, LLC for improvements to the property located at 418 Peoples Street for a total incentive amount not to exceed \$8,975, effective upon signature by the City Manager or designee.

SUMMARY:

This motion authorizes a Reimbursement Agreement for Furman Foundry, LLC in the amount of \$8,975 from the Commercial Finish Out (Landlord) Program. The owner proposes improvements to the vacant space to prepare for a future tenant.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

The Incentive Programs adopted by the TIRZ #3 Board in the Project and Financing Plan are specially structured to encourage specific types of development, the key to our community's long-term goal of Downtown Revitalization. The Commercial Finish Out Program was created to assist businesses in the Reinvestment Zone with regard to interior permanent/semi-permanent finish-out improvements.

Furman Foundry, LLC has been redeveloping The Foundry into a mixed-used property offering space for professional, retail, and dining services. The owner proposes all new mechanical, electrical and plumbing installation as well as a drywall installation to separate the retail space in preparation for one of their new tenants, Thunderbird Wine & Spirits, LLC.

Thunderbird Wine & Spirits will be a premium wine and spirits store offering a variety of alcoholic beverages, pre-packaged charcuterie, specialty snacks, gift items, and tobacco/nicotine products to serve the growing downtown area.

ALTERNATIVES:

The Board could not approve this agreement or limit the incentive amount.

FINANCIAL IMPACT:

The funding source for this project is from the TIRZ #3 Commercial Finish-Out (Landlord) Program. The budget for this program is \$8,975.
