

Resolution authorizing the submission of a grant application to the U.S. Department of Defense, Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation, for the FY 2026 Defense Community Infrastructure Program (DCIP) for funding in the amount of \$17,721,365.53 for the Leopard Street & Up River Road Water Line Replacement Project with a cash match of \$7,594,870.94 from the Water Capital Fund.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes submission of a grant application by the City of Corpus Christi ("City") to the U.S. Department of Defense, Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation, for the FY 2026 Defense Community Infrastructure Program (DCIP) for funding in the amount of \$17,721,365.53 to complete the Leopard Street & Up River Road Water Line Replacement Project for the Corpus Christi Water Department.

SECTION 2. No cash match is required to apply for this grant. However, if awarded, there is a cash match requirement of \$7,594,870.94 from Water Capital Fund.

SECTION 3. The City Council designates the Corpus Christi Water Chief Operating Officer and the City Director of Finance & Procurement, and their designees, as the City's authorized officials. Each authorized official is empowered to apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant and its funding, execute all necessary documents, and administer the grant on behalf of the City as the applicant agency.

SECTION 4. In the event of the loss or misuse of these DCIP grant funds, the City assures that the funds will be returned to the U.S. Department of Defense, Office of Local Defense Community Cooperation, in full.
