

CORPUS CHRISTI AQUIFER STORAGE AND RECOVERY CONSERVATION DISTRICT

Section 8811.024 of Texas Special District Local Laws Code requires City Council to confirm the election of officers annually. The board is recommending the confirmation of the following officers: Dan McGinn as President, Andrew Molly as Vice-President and Jeffrey Edmonds as Secretary.

Duties

The Corpus Christi Aquifer Storage and Recovery Conservation District develops and protects municipal aquifer storage areas created by the City of Corpus Christi. The district may implement and develop aquifer storage and recovery projects.

Composition

Five (5) directors appointed by the City Council to serve four-year staggered terms. If a vacancy occurs on the board, the board may appoint a director to serve the remainder of the term. The board shall annually elect officers and officers must be confirmed by the City Council. The initial directors shall draw lots to determine which three (3) directors shall serve four-year terms that expire at the end of the calendar year four years after the effective date of the Act, and which two directors shall serve two-year terms that expire at the end of the calendar year two years after the effective date of the Act.
