Accepting and appropriating the FY 2017 Operation Stonegarden Grant Program

**CAPTION:** Ordinance accepting \$336,443 from State of Texas Governor's Homeland Security Grants Division for funding eligible under FY2017 Department of Homeland Security Grant Program - Operation Stonegarden; and appropriating \$336,443 in Police Grants Fund.

**PURPOSE:**

Accept the grant and appropriate the funds.

**BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:**

The purpose is to support state and local efforts to prevent terrorism and other catastrophic events and to prepare the Nation for the threats and hazards that pose the greatest risk to the security of the United States. The Police Department agrees to conduct operations designed to reduce border-security risk. Tactical operations will be conducted on a periodic basis on overtime.

The grant will pay for overtime, miscellaneous equipment, vehicle maintenance, and fuel.

The grant period is from March 1, 2018 – May 31, 2019
