Ordinance authorizing execution of Amendment No.6 of grant contract with Texas Department of State Health to perform Level 3 chemical laboratory surge capacity activities from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) in support of public health emergency preparedness. For the contract period July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023 (“Fiscal Year 2023” or “FY2023”); Increases the total contract value by \$226,103.00 (reflecting \$205,548.00 in federal funding and \$20,555.00 in match funding) for FY2023.

Background and Staff Recommendation

- Laboratory Response Network (LRN-PHEP) Grant Program
 - To be used to provide activities in support of the Public Health Emergency Preparedness Cooperative Agreement. Pay for personnel costs, supplies, and other expenses; to provide a Public Health Emergency Preparedness Laboratory Response Program to maintain and support an action plan to respond to an act of bioterrorism and biological threats in the community. Perform activities in the following county/ies of San Patricio, Nueces, Aransas, Jim Wells, Kleberg, Victoria, Bee, Calhoun, Goliad, Jackson, Live Oak, and Refugio.
 - July 1, 2022, through June 30, 2023
