BACKGROUND:

The Naval Air Station Corpus Christi Joint Land Use Study (JLUS) is a project that was initiated by City Council resolution to accept a federal grant from the Department of Defense Office of Economic Adjustment in April of 2011. The JLUS was conducted as a collaborative planning effort to encourage compatible land uses near NASCC associated airfields. The JLUS contains a set of recommendations that would prevent or mitigate encroachment in the areas surrounding the four airfields that NASCC uses for their military training missions. The four airfields are:

- NASCC Truax Field
- NASCC Cabaniss Field
- NASCC Waldron Field
- Corpus Christi International
- Airport (CCIA)
