## CONTRACT AMENDMENT TO THE GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE TEXAS COMMISSION ON ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY AND CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI

## **Amendment Number 1**

In accordance with Section 1.2 *Amendments*, of the General Terms and Conditions, Contract Number 582-14-40055 may be amended upon mutual agreement of the parties. The Texas Legislature, 83<sup>rd</sup> Legislative Session, increased the funding for Rider 8 Air Quality Planning. This amendment is being done to increase the Maximum Authorized Reimbursement of the grant, which was originally based on the amount appropriated during the 82<sup>nd</sup> Legislative Session. The Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) and the City of Corpus Christi (Performing Party) agree to amend the Grant as follows:

## 1. MAXIMUM AUTHORIZED REIMBURSEMENT

TCEQ and Performing Party agree to increase the Maximum Authorized Reimbursement shown on the Contract Signature Page by One hundred fifty-three thousand eight hundred ninety-five dollars (\$153,895). The original Maximum Authorized Reimbursement, the amount of the increase, and the amended Maximum Authorized Reimbursement are as follows:
