## RESOLUTION FINDING THAT IT IS ADVISABLE THAT THE CORPUS CHRISTI BUSINESS AND JOB DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION BE RESTATED AND AMENDED; AUTHORIZING ADOPTION OF THE RESTATED AND AMENDED ARTICLES; APPROVING THE FORM OF THE RESTATED AND AMENDED ARTICLES

**WHEREAS**, on September 26, 2000, the City Council approved the original articles of incorporation for the Corpus Christi Business and Job Development Corporation, a Type A Corporation ("the Corporation") for the expenditure of sales tax money approved by the voters of the City of Corpus Christi on the city seawall and the local civic arena;

**WHEREAS**, in 2002 the voters of the City additionally approved a sales tax funding jobs, job training, business development, affordable housing, and a baseball stadium;

**WHEREAS**, the articles of incorporation for the Corporation need to be amended to accurately state these additional allowed uses and should also be restated to comply with the present laws regarding business organizations;

## THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI THAT:

**SECTION 1.** The City Council of the City of Corpus Christi finds that it is advisable for the reasons stated above for the Corporation to adopt the Restated and Amended Articles of Incorporation, attached to this Resolution as Attachment "A" and incorporated to this Resolution for all purposes;

**SECTION 2.** The City Council authorizes the Corporation to adopt the Restated and Amended Articles and file them with the Texas Secretary of State;

**SECTION 3.** The City Council approved the form of the Restated and Amended Articles.
