Resolution authorizing a three-year supply agreement with Broen, Inc., of Houston, in an amount up to \$531,977.40 to purchase valves and parts utilized by CC Gas, with FY 2025 funding of \$103,440.05 from Gas CIP Funds.

WHEREAS, CC Gas needs ball valves, PE valves, and associated parts that are critical in sustaining their operational reliability for service;

WHEREAS, State law provides that such procurements, as outlined above, are subject to statutory procurement requirements, including competitive bids, unless an exception applies; and

WHEREAS, the City Council finds that there are at least three statutory exceptions for this procurement in the Texas Local Government Code, Sections 252.022(a)(2), (a)(7)(A), and (a)(7)(D), as this procurement: (i) is necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the municipality's residents; (ii) is available from only one source due to patents, copyrights, secret processes, or natural monopolies: and (iii) consists of captive replacement parts or components for equipment, respectively; therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopts such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this procurement.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute a three-year supply agreement with Broen, Inc., for an amount up to \$531,977.40, with FY 2025 funding of \$103,440.05 from Gas CIP Funds.
