

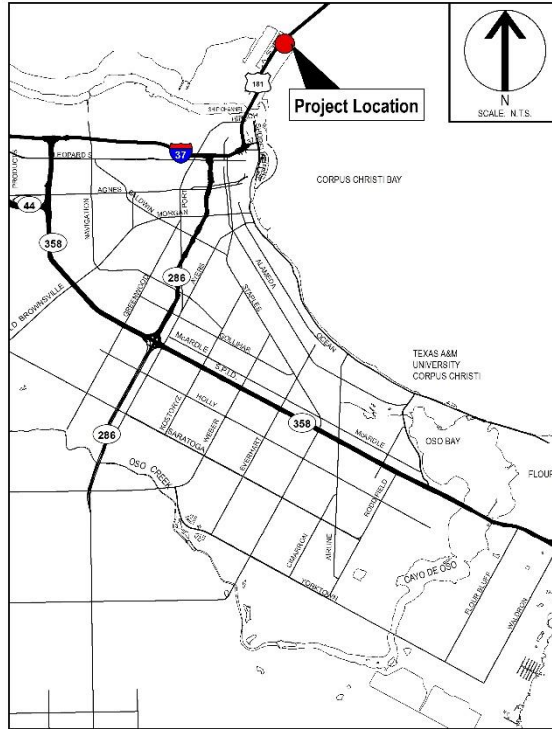

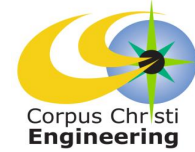


Project Location





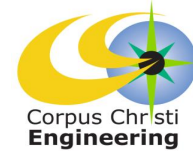
Project Vicinity



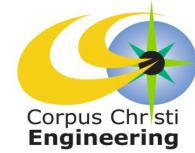


Wetland Mitigation

Harbor Bridge Replacement Project (HBPRP)



- ✓ Texas Department of Transportation (TxDOT) required to conduct environmental mitigation
 - 2014 - City & TxDOT began coordination for mitigation site locations
 - 2014 - City committed use of City wetlands located on North Beach
 - 2014 - Final Environmental Impact Statement (FEIS)
 - 2016 - Record of Decision (ROD) confirmed mitigation
- ✓ Flatiron Dragados , LLC (FDLLC) (TxDOT's design builder) developing mitigation plan with the United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) through a 404 permit
 - FDLLC has included future plans for an Eco Park in the permitting portion with USACE
 - 404 permit requires deed restrictions on property for use to remain wetlands in perpetuity
- ✓ **THIS ITEM:**
 - **Dedicating 16.744 acres as wetland preserve**
 - **Placing deed restrictions to be held in perpetuity as wetland preserve**
