Description of Scope:

4. Deliverables:

a. Electronic PDF Files.

5. Exclusions:

- a. Plan Review and Permitting Fees from authorities having jurisdiction.
- b. Any consultants not listed above in the Description of Scope section.

We will pass the cost of reimbursable expenses at a rate of 1.15 times the expenses incurred by our firm and consultants. Reimbursable expenses, <u>if any</u>, are as follows:

- 12. Bid services: preparing bid documents, pre-bid conference at the site, addendums, reviewing submitted bids and providing a contractor recommendation based on the submitted bids.
- 13. Architectural Construction Administration: pay application review, submittal review, RFI's, interim site observations and a final site observation to provide a final punch list to the contractor, etc.
