Ordinance authorizing the City Manager or designee to execute a Waterline Easement to dedicate and grant to the Coastal Bend Bays and Estuaries Program (CBBEP) a fifteen (15) foot wide easement across a 8.646-acre City-owned tract of land to construct a potable waterline across city property for purposes of supplying potable water to the CBBEP's education facility, located on CBBEP-owned land.

## BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

**Section 1.** The City Manager or designee is authorized to execute a Waterline Easement dedicating and granting to the Coastal Bend Bays and Estuaries Program (CBBEP)(a 501(c)3 non-profit and Texas not-for-profit organization and political subdivision of the State of Texas) a fifteen foot wide easement across a 8.646-acre tract of City-owned land to allow the CBBEP to construct and operate a potable water line to the Nueces Delta Preserve, for purposes of providing potable water to the CBBEP's new education facility located approximately 3 miles southwest of Odem, Texas, for the city public purpose, benefit and interest in promoting environmental tourism and nature education programs in the area.
