

Ordinance transferring \$88,459.57 from the unspent project balance in Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Program Fund No. 3280 to General Fund No. 1020 for unexpended renovation/repair funds from the T.C. Ayers Pool project; and amending the operating budget.

WHEREAS, on March 28, 2017, the City Council passed Ordinance No. 031104 to appropriate and transfer \$712,558 from the unreserved fund balance in General Fund No. 1020 to the Parks and Recreation Capital Improvement Program (CIP) Fund No. 3280, Project T17021, to complete renovations and repairs to the T.C. Ayers Pool; the renovation/repair project has been completed; and the remaining unspent funds are being transferred back to the General Fund.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Funds in the amount of \$88,459.57 are transferred from the unspent project balance in Parks and Recreation CIP Fund No. 3280 to General Fund No. 1020. Additionally, the FY2019 Operating Budget, adopted by Ordinance No. 031548, is amended to increase revenues \$88,459.57.
