

Resolution authorizing the purchase of 15 chest compression units and 25 defibrillator units for the Fire Department in the amount of \$272,536.25 and execution of a five-year maintenance agreement for \$130,067.00 with Stryker Sales, LLC, of Kalamazoo, Michigan, with FY 2022 funding of \$272,536.25 for the equipment purchase and \$26,013.40 for the initial year of the maintenance agreement from the General Fund.

WHEREAS, the Fire Department needs prompt and reliable life-saving equipment in order to provide emergency service to citizens;

WHEREAS, State law provides that such procurements, as outlined above, are subject to statutory procurement requirements, including competitive bids, unless an exemption applies; and

WHEREAS, there is a statutory exemption for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a)(2), as this purchase is necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the City’s residents.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopts such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this procurement.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to purchase 15 chest compression units and 25 defibrillator units for the Fire Department for \$272,536.25 and execution of a five-year maintenance agreement for \$130,067.00 with Stryker Sales, LLC, of Kalamazoo, Michigan, with FY 2022 funding of \$272,536.25 for the equipment purchase and \$26,013.40 for the initial year of the maintenance agreement from the General Fund.
