Purpose and Objective

- **Ordinance passed May 28**
- **Proposed Changes Should:**
 - Provide Clarity
 - Promote equity among customers
 - Improve efficiency of restrictions



Proposed Changes

- **Definitions**
 - Provide clarity
- **Irrigation testing**
 - Ability to test irrigation systems outside of designated watering times
- **Decorative Fountains**
 - Small residential fountains allowed in stages 2 and 3.
 - Commercial fountains require permit in stages 2 and 3.
 - During stage 4, no fountains will operate unless it is necessary to maintain equipment.



Proposed Changes

- **Fire Hydrant Use**

- Hydrant use for construction purposes will continue in Stage 3 and 4
- Permit required in Stage 2, 3, and 4
- 10% Surcharge in Stage 4; Consistent with Industrial Customers

- **Revision Since Aug. 27 Council Meeting:**

- Clarification made to section on water service termination (page 16)
 - States when such measures would take effect
 - Differentiates between residential and non-residential conditions
