

# Amendment to Water Resource Management Ordinance

## **Purpose and Objective**

- Ordinance passed May 28
- Proposed Changes Should:
  - Provide Clarity
  - Promote equity among customers
  - Improve efficiency of restrictions



## **Proposed Changes**

#### Definitions

Provide clarity

#### Irrigation testing

 Ability to test irrigation systems outside of designated watering times

#### Decorative Fountains

- Small residential fountains allowed in stages 2 and 3.
- Commercial fountains require permit in stages 2 and 3.
- During stage 4, no fountains will operate unless it is necessary to maintain equipment.



### **Proposed Changes**

#### Fire Hydrant Use

- Hydrant use for construction purposes will continue in Stage 3 and
- Permit required in Stage 2, 3, and 4
- 10% Surcharge in Stage 4; Consistent with Industrial Customers

#### Revision Since Aug. 27 Council Meeting:

- Clarification made to section on water service termination (page 16)
  - States when such measures would take effect
  - <u>Differentiates between residential and non-residential conditions</u>
