## Resolution authorizing an Air Service Minimum Revenue Guarantee Program project, totaling up to \$700,000, to expand Corpus Christi International Airport services and retain or create primary jobs.

**WHEREAS**, on August 3, 2022, the Corpus Christi International Airport (CCIA) was awarded a \$750,000 air service development grant from the U.S. Department of Transportation;

**WHEREAS**, the Small Community Air Service Development (SCASD) grant aims to ensure a Minimum Revenue Guarantee to provide financial incentives to airline carriers, conduct studies on the possibilities of expanded service, and carry out marketing programs to promote existing local services;

**WHEREAS**, the Corpus Christi B Corporation Air Service Minimum Revenue Guarantee Program project will expense up to \$700,000, from the B Corporation Economic Development Fund Fiscal Year 2025-26 for airport expansion as part of the SCASD grant program; and

**WHEREAS**, the Air Service Minimum Revenue Guarantee Program project will stimulate economic growth for the City of Corpus Christi in offering a new hub that connects to the Western half of the United States, bringing more travelers to Corpus Christi to use CCIA.

## Be it resolved by the Corpus Christi B Corporation Board of Directors:

**Section 1.** The Corpus Christi B Corporation specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this resolution are true and correct and adopt such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this project.

**Section 2.** The Corpus Christi B Corporation conducted a public hearing for this project on July 21, 2025, in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Chapter 505, and finds that the Air Service Minimum Revenue Guarantee Program project promotes CCIA service or business expansion in accordance with Texas Local Government Code Section 505.155.

**Section 3.** The Corpus Christi B Corporation authorizes an Air Service Minimum Revenue Guarantee Program project, totaling up to \$700,000 in FY2025-26, to expand Corpus Christi International Airport services and retain or create primary jobs.
