## **5.** <u>25-0155</u> Capital Improvement Projects Update

Mr. Atwood advised that a few piles on the fixed section of L pier need to be fixed since they were installed incorrectly. The final dredge report for the basin came in and they will move on to the bulkhead in front of the davit next week. SR Trident has mostly completed driving the finger pier piles for the Peoples Street Boardwalk. Next week they will work from the shoreside to drive piles near Harrison's Landing. The completion date is estimated to be the middle or end of August 2025. The Coopers Alley Boater's Facility project will go out for a bid as soon as possible, with Engineering finalizing the paperwork. The haul out facility project is delayed due to CCW's project.

Chairman Broomfield asked Mr. Atwood to discuss the breakwater, Mr. Atwood gave a brief history of the structure and the projects the Engineering Department has completed and will do in the future to repair it.

## 7. 25-08010 Hurricane Preparedness of Marina

Mr. Atwood went on to advise on the marina's preparedness for hurricane season. Marina administrative staff has sent out hurricane preparation reminders to tenants, staff walks the docks and contacts tenants that have issues with their lines, sails, bilge pumps, etc. If a tenant is not responsive to our communications staff will go ahead and replace old lines, remove biminis, or secure sails to ensure the safety of neighboring boats and the docks.
