

Dock Replacement Project


- Design phase 100% complete

- A and B docks 65% cleared of boats






- Phase I Docks L, A, and B with dredging
 - Phase II docks C and D with dredging





- Selecting engineering firm for design January/February 2022 with RFQ process
- Some changes pending marina master plan
- Upgrades will include green spaces and landscaping on Coopers L Head, large meeting rooms, more public restroom facilities, more restroom and shower facilities for tenants, office space for marina staff and haul out yard contractors, storage space for marina equipment, and retail space on the seawall.
