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Dockless Scooter Briefing

ISSUE:

Dockless scooters have had a presence in Corpus Christi since 2019. This briefing will present proposed changes to the dockless scooter fee structure to be more in line with the major cities across the state of Texas, to create a cap on the maximum number of scooters allowed in the city limits and on the Seawall; and to add designated parking requirements to the license agreement for dockless vehicles for pedestrian safety and right of way.

BACKGROUND:

Since January of 2019, dockless vehicles have provided riders greater access to our Downtown Corpus Christi (i.e., from the Seawall to Downtown businesses) area, improving access to the SEA District, Marina Arts District and Hospital District for both leisure activities and to and from work. City Staff has now gathered almost two years' worth of scooter data to better understand how scooters are used in the city. Using the results of the data and peer city program comparisons, staff is proposing program modifications to make the program work better for Corpus Christi.
