

Ordinance approving the addition of one full-time position to the budget of the Procurement Division of the Finance & Procurement Department for a Contract Manager, as recommended by the City Audit Committee; and amending the FY 2022 Operating Budget to increase the number of positions by one, with funding coming from the existing FY 2022 Procurement operational budget.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

Section 1. The fiscal year 2021-2022 ("FY 2022") Operating Budget, approved by Ordinance 032539, is amended to add one full-time equivalent ("FTE") position for a Contract Manager, including the required salary and benefits, to the total number of FTEs shown for the Procurement Division of the Finance & Procurement Department, as recommended by the Audit Committee.

Section 2. The FY 2022 Operating Budget is amended to increase by one the total number of FTEs to be paid from currently budgeted FY 2022 operational funds of the Procurement Division budget, resulting in no increase to revenues nor expenditures in the FY 2022 Operating Budget.
