Zoning Pattern and Adjacent Development





Staff Analysis and Recommendation



- The proposed rezoning is generally consistent with the adopted Comprehensive Plan (Plan CC) and warrants an amendment to the Future Land Use Map. The proposed rezoning is compatible with the adjoining properties and does not have a negative impact upon the adjacent properties.
- A proposed north/south "C1" Minor Collector Street traverses the subject property and connects Yorktown Boulevard to the singlefamily residential subdivision located to the north of the subject property across Master Channel 31.
- Based on 14.834 acres, minus 20% for infrastructure equals 11.867 acres of developable land. 11.867 acres at 22 dwelling units per acre equals a potential maximum buildout of 261 dwelling units.
- Similar rezonings occurred in 2014 to multifamily zoning districts along the Yorktown Boulevard corridor.
- Planning Commission and Staff Recommendation: Approval
