Good Afternoon PRAC members,

This was discussed at the December PRAC committee meeting. I have attached the code for reference. The City Secretary's Office is currently working on a future agenda item to amend Chapter 2 of the Code of Ordinances regarding City advisory boards. Chapter 2 defines the membership, terms, and functions of advisory boards. Obtaining amendment recommendations from Staff/Committee will help in the goal of making the boards more successful and productive in reaching their overall goals.

I was informed by the City Secretary's office that there is additional time to submit recommendations as they plan to bundle recommendations and tentatively schedule for Council approval at the end of January. Other advisory committees are involved such as the Marina and ISAC.

I will be adding this item back to the January agenda for PRAC discussion but you can also email me any of your recommendations.

Assistant City Attorney Aimee Alcorn-Reed will be preparing the ordinance. Recommendations will be forwarded to her and the City Secretary's Office. The City Secretary's Office would like to have the ordinance drafted/finalized before the City Council resumes making committee appointments.
