

Resolution authorizing submission of grant application for \$367,441.52 to the State of Texas under the Victims of Crime Act for salaries and benefits for four civilian positions for the Corpus Christi Police Department's Victim Assistance Program, with \$18,080.00 in-kind services.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS THAT:

SECTION 1. The City Council authorizes submission of the grant application to the State of Texas in the amount of \$367,441.52 for funding available under the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) Fund for the Police Department's Family Violence Unit to continue the Victim Assistance Program.

SECTION 2. The City Council commits to provide for the applicable contribution of \$18,080.00 in-kind services.

SECTION 3. The City Council designates the Chief of Police as the grantee's authorized official. The authorized official may apply for, accept, reject, alter, or terminate the grant.

SECTION 4. In the event of the loss or misuse of these State of Texas funds, the City of Corpus Christi assures that the funds will be returned to the State of Texas in full.
