Birth Defects

- EPA released Poster P-371
- Nueces County increase in birth defects and low birth weight in prenatal residents that live near refinery row.
- Does not account for poor diet, higher than average poverty levels and length of gestation.



Eagle Ford Shale

- Rural areas struggling to accommodate infrastructure, workforce, medical and housing needs
- 5000 new wells by 2020; adding 68,000 full time jobs
