

## Ordinance

**Authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute 1) a Farm Lease Agreement with Matt Danysh Farms, Inc. to lease and farm approximately 870.703 acres of farm land located at the Corpus Christi International Airport and 2) a Farm Lease Agreement with S & S Farms Partnership to lease and farm approximately 591.374 acres of farm land located at the Airport, both in consideration of an annual payment to the City of \$55 per leased acre, both for a term of five (5) years.**

**Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:**

**SECTION 1.** That the City Manager, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute 1) a Farm Lease Agreement with Matt Danysh Farms, Inc. to lease and farm approximately 870.703 acres of farm land located at the Corpus Christi International Airport, which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit A, and 2) a Farm Lease Agreement with S & S Farms Partnership to lease and farm approximately 591.374 acres of farm land located at the Corpus Christi International Airport, which agreement is attached hereto as Exhibit B, both in consideration of an annual payment to the City of \$55 per leased acre, both for a term of five (5) years.
