Resolution

Authorizing the submission of a grant application in the amount of \$78,273.18 to the State of Texas, Criminal Justice Division for funding available under the Victims of Crime Act (VOCA) fund for the Police Department's Family Violence Unit to continue Year 3 of the Victim Outreach Program with a city match of \$13,368.30 and \$6,200 in-kind services, for a total project cost of \$97,841.48; and authorizing the City Manager or the City Manager's designee to apply for, accept, reject, alter or terminate the grant.
