Ordinance authorizing the City Manager or designee, to execute a Revocable Surface Easement Abandonment Agreement ("Agreement") with Avinash C. Ahuja and Peggy B. Ahuja ("Owners") to construct and maintain a brick wall, within the Ocean Way public street right-of-way.

# CAPTION:

Ordinance authorizing the City Manager or designee, to execute a Revocable Surface Easement Abandonment Agreement ("Agreement") with Avinash C. Ahuja and Peggy B. Ahuja ("Owners"), to construct and maintain a masonry brick wall, extending approximately 50-square feet into the public right-of-way while occupying an additional 138-square feet of public right-of-way (approximately 188 total square feet), subject to Owners' compliance with specified conditions.

#### PURPOSE:

The purpose of the Agreement is to allow the Owners the ability to construct and maintain a brick wall, in an unneeded portion of the present Ocean Way public street right-of-way.

# **BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS**:

Owners desire to construct and maintain a masonry brick wall, extending approximately 50-square feet into the public right-of-way while occupying an additional 138-square feet of public right-of-way (approximately 188 total square feet) of the present Ocean Way public street right-of-way.

Staff recommends that the Owners pay a one-time surface easement abandonment agreement fee of \$3,215.00 for the use of the construction of a masonry brick wall (approximately 50-square feet into the public right-of-way while occupying an additional

138-square feet of public right-of-way (approximately 188 total square feet) into the existing Ocean Way public street right-of-way, prior to the Agreement request going to City Council.

### ALTERNATIVES:

Deny the Agreement request.
