**Section 2.** That \$5,000 donation from Port Industries of Corpus Christi is accepted and appropriated into the No. 1020 General Fund to be used by the City for payment of services provided under the Interlocal Agreement.

**Section 3**. That the FY 2014-2015 Operating Budget adopted by Ordinance Number 030294 is hereby changed to increase revenues and expenditures by \$5,000 each.
