Resolution finding that competitive bids are not required for procurement from Lytx, Inc., and authorizing the City Manager, or designee, to execute agreements with Lytx, Inc., totaling \$133,225.26 for the purchase of additional hardware and software to expand the vehicle-mounted camera program for the Solid Waste Operations Department.

WHEREAS, the City currently has a program in place that utilizes vehiclemounted cameras on Solid Waste Operations Department ("Solid Waste") vehicles in an effort to reduce the number of preventable accidents and improve safe operation by employees and the safety of the public;

WHEREAS, the current program will be expanded by adding cameras to equip more Solid Waste vehicles than are presently equipped;

WHEREAS, additional hardware and related software subscriptions must be purchased in order to expand the program;

WHEREAS, State law provides that such procurements, as outlined above, are subject to statutory procurement requirements, including competitive bids, unless an exception applies; and

WHEREAS, there is a statutory exception for this procurement in Local Government Code, Section 252.022(a)(2), as this purchase relates to items necessary to preserve or protect the public health or safety of the municipality's residents.

Be it resolved by the City Council of the City of Corpus Christi, Texas:

Section 1. The City Council specifically finds that the foregoing statements included in the preamble of this ordinance are true and correct and adopts such findings for all intents and purposes related to the authorization of this procurement.

Section 2. The City Manager, or his designee, is authorized to execute agreements with Lytx, Inc., totaling \$133,225.26 for the purchase of additional hardware and software subscriptions to expand the vehicle-mounted camera program for Solid Waste vehicles.
