Carport Definition

A roofed structure with three or more open sides used for vehicle shelter and parking. A carport may either be free standing or attached to the primary building.



Carports in the City: Wood/Metal






Carports in the City: Metal







Carports in City






Issues:

- Location on the property, structures are prohibited from being located within the front yard building setback.
- Permitting and structural integrity of the carport.
 - Why? Relatively low cost and can be installed over the weekend.



Typical layout





Permitting:

- 250 permits have been pulled since 1995 for carport structures (3% of the 9,800).
 - Issues in determining if a permit was pulled:
 - Records only available through 1995
 - Inconsistent data entry into building permit system (accessory structure vs. carport) over the years.
