Ordering a General Election to elect Mayor and Eight Council Members - November 8, 2016

CAPTION:

Ordinance ordering a general election to be held on November 8, 2016, in the City of Corpus Christi for the election of Mayor and Eight Council Members; providing for procedures for holding such election; providing for notice of election and publication thereof; providing for establishment of branch early polling places; designating polling place locations; authorizing a joint election with Nueces County, and a runoff election, if one is necessary; and enacting provisions incident and relating to the subject and purpose of this ordinance.

PURPOSE:

This item will allow for a general election to be held on November 8, 2016 to elect mayor and eight council members; and allow the City to enter into a joint election with Nueces County.

BACKGROUND AND FINDINGS:

Per the City Charter, the regular election of the mayor and eight council members shall be held on the November uniform election date of even-numbered years as authorized by State law. As in the past, the City can conduct a joint election with Nueces County if approved by Council.

This ordinance complies with the requirements of the Texas Government Code, the Texas Election Code, and the City Charter.
