Over 190 parks are listed by category and amenities in this document. Surveys indicate that parks are very important to residents and visitors—they enrich the quality of life and are a critical factor which impacts our city's economic development.

The Facilities Map shows nine of our city parks (Cole Park, West Guth Park, Dr. Hector P. Garcia Park, St. Andrews Park, Lamar Park, Lakeview Park, Shernill Park, Artesian Park and Billish Park), along with our gyms, pools, recreation centers, senior centers, golf courses, tennis centers, cultural center, youth & family service centers, and the four beaches we maintain.
