ORDINANCE

APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE TAX INCREMENT REINVESTMENT ZONE #3 AMENDED PROJECT & FINANCING PLAN APPROVED BY THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF REINVESTMENT ZONE NUMBER THREE, CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS ON AUGUST 23, 2016.

WHEREAS, in 2008, through Ordinance 027996, the City of Corpus Christi created a tax increment financing district, to be known as "Reinvestment Zone Number Three, Corpus Christi, Texas," over a portion of the city that includes the City's downtown area;

WHEREAS, Ordinance 027996 included a preliminary reinvestment zone financing plan:

WHEREAS, on August 25, 2015, the City Council passed Ordinance 030592, which approved the "Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone #3 Amended Project & Financing Plan";

WHEREAS, on August 23, 2016, the Board of Directors of Reinvestment Zone Number Three passed a resolution approving a second amendment to Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone #3 Amended Project & Financing Plan;

WHEREAS, Texas Tax Code Section 311.011(d) provides that the governing body of the municipality that designated the zone must approve a project plan or reinvestment zone financing plan after its adoption by the board and the approval must be by ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL FOR THE CITY OF CORPUS CHRISTI, TEXAS:

SECTION 1. The City Council approves the Tax Increment Reinvestment Zone #3 Amended Project & Financing Plan ("the Plan") for the Reinvestment Zone Number Three, Corpus Christi, Texas, as amended and approved by the Board of Directors of Reinvestment Zone Number Three by resolution on August 23, 2016. A copy of the Plan is attached hereto and incorporated as "**Exhibit A**."
