History

- The City of Corpus Christi received Preliminary Flood Insurance Rate Maps on October 23, 2015.
 - On or about June 8, 2016 and June 16, 2016 The Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA) published notice of a 90-day appeal period in the Corpus Christi Caller Times.
 - The appeal period is open to any owner or lessee or real property in the community who believes his or her property rights will be adversely affected by the proposed flood hazard determinations.
 - The appeal period started on June 16, 2016 and ended September 13, 2016.
