Continuing the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance



Section 370.002 of the Local Government Code requires a city, on the third anniversary of its juvenile curfew ordinance and every third year thereafter, to review the ordinance's effects on the community and on problems the ordinance was intended to remedy, to hold public hearings on the need to continue the ordinance, and to determine whether to abolish, continue, or modify the ordinance.



Continuing the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance



A person commits an offense if he/she:

- (1) Is a minor; and
- (2) Appears in a public place between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 6:00 a.m., or on a Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, or Friday between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.



Continuing the Juvenile Curfew Ordinance

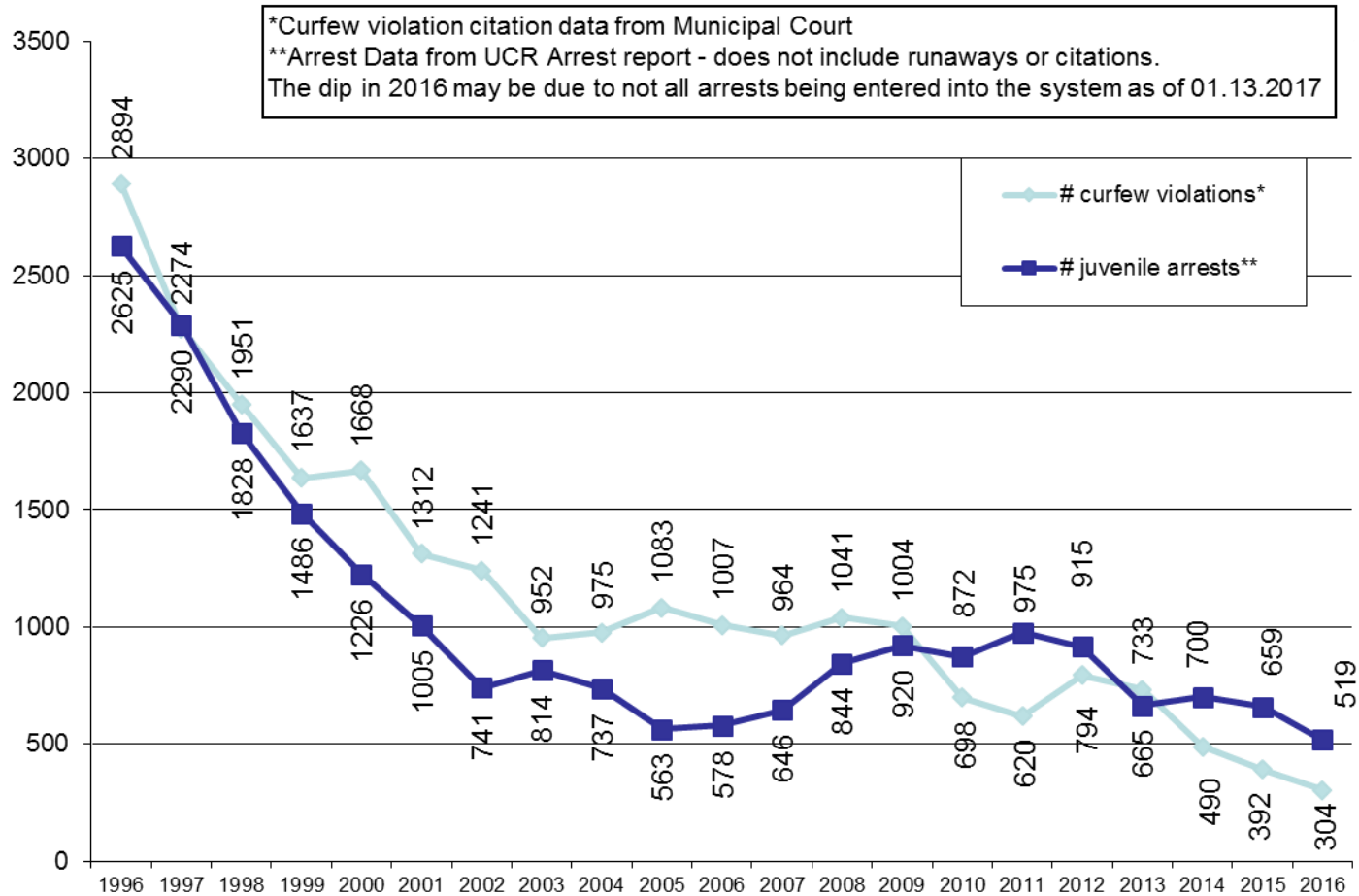


- The City of Corpus Christi has had a nighttime curfew ordinance since the 1950's 11pm – 6am

The Ordinance was amended in 1994 and 1995 to include daytime curfew 9am – 4pm
